We will need a lot of baking to make this a success!

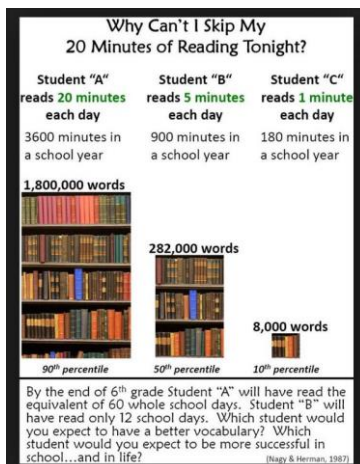
Many Hands Make Light Work
