#### **School Operating Hours**

#### Attendance

Attendance is an important area for our school in 2024 and vital for all students to maximise learning each day. School rolls are a legal document and all absences are recorded for attendance records. Please ensure your child/ren is only missing school when they are sick or have an appointment that could not be made outside of school hours or the holidays. All student absences need to be reported to the school office. Every day in our classrooms, our students are learning and achieving. Work missed through absence can be very difficult to catch up.

All students will again be bringing home their Weekly Report each Friday, commencing today! This report is designed to give a regular overview of student progress in the classroom throughout the term, thus

Our very active Project Club will have another busy year ahead of them. All fundraising activities will be advertised in our weekly newsletter, each Friday.




#### Tuckshop
