Grow our School Improvement by focussing on three key areas: Teaching and Learning practices, with a focus on automaticity of Number Facts; a successful and professional workforce/teaching team and our Age Appropriate Pedagogy journey for Learning. Dallarnil State School already supports students' individual learning and we aim to achieve high standards. In 2022, we aim to promote individual successes through our weekly data collection and information to parents. This will be further embedded as part of our culture.

- All students will be above the National Minimum Standards in Mathematics and English.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving A or B across all Year levels.
- Increase the percentage of students in Year 3 and Year 5 achieving in the Upper 2 Bands for NAPLAN.
- Access Professional Development for staff around Age Appropriate Pedagogies and Positive Behaviour for Learning Conference.
- Continue to support the school's Instrumental Music Program – Guitar – weekly – Years 4-6.
- Continue to support Literacy and Numeracy strategies in the classrooms.

Our initiatives include

- Learning Goals in Literacy and Numeracy will be developed for all students, using the Continua – value added targets for all students. Number facts to be one goal.
- Provide targeted Professional Learning (including PBL Conference, Age Appropriate Pedagogies and The Reading Centre) supported by planning, modelling, observation and feedback.
